If the Sponsor cannot make this event, a parent or family member can stand in proxy. This event will take place at Holy Family Church from 6:30pm-7:30pm.

CANDIDATE LETTER TO THE BISHOP

- Letter should be typed and addressed "Dear Bishop"
- •Opening paragraph should introduce yourself to the Bishop, state that you are a Candidate for Confirmation and then tell a little bit about yourself: the Church you belong to, the school you go to, the community you live in
- •The next few paragraphs should talk about your Journey to Confirmation: your formation sessions, your life experiences, the retreat, the food drive
- •Select one of the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit and explain how you will be a "Witness to Christ" using that gift
- •Ask to be confirmed: Based on my journey this past year, I feel that I am ready to be sealed with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit and accept the new and more challenging responsibilities that come with this Sacrament.

- There is no minimum requirement for this letter. Please remember that the Bishop has never met you and the more you can tell him about your faith journey the better.

SERVICE PROJECT INFORMATION

Each Candidate is responsible for completing ten hours of service: We recommend that the hours be divided as follows: 5 hours of service at Holy Family Parish and 5 hours within the community. Service is giving of one's time where payment is not received for work completed. It is recommended that the candidate begin working on this responsibility sooner rather than later! Please use the tracking sheet to record dates, locations, hours completed and a signature of the person for whom the Candidate volunteered. These hours are due no later than **March 11**th, **2018**.

Note: Community Service does not count if it is done for parents! That's called chores, not service!
