FAITH FORMATION WILL NO LONGER BE HELD ON TUESDAY NIGHTS!

The following changes will be made in the upcoming year to improve Faith Formation:

- **Grades K, 1, 3, 4, 5, & 6:** will be offered on Sundays from 10 – 11:15AM and Mondays from 6:15-7:30PM
- **Grade 2 Faith Formation** will be offered only on Monday nights from 6:15 – 7:30PM. The sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are taught during Grade 2 and it is necessary that your child is thoroughly prepared. It is highly recommended that, if you have a child in Grade 1, they attend Faith Formation in order to help prepare them for the upcoming Grade 2 Sacramental Preparation year.
- **Grade 7 & 8 Faith Formation** will be offered on Monday nights only in the church hall from 6:15 – 7:30PM. This will be taught using the EDGE ministry curriculum.
- **Confirmation 1** will continue on Sundays from 10-11:30AM and **Confirmation 2** will continue on Sundays from 11:45AM – 1:15PM. There will be 3 required Masses for C1 and C2 to attend as a group and this is during a class time, with C1 attending Mass at 10:30AM and C2 attending at the 12:15PM Mass. If you have a child who attends parochial high school, it is required that they attend the second year of Confirmation but it is not mandatory that they attend Confirmation 1. (Though it is highly recommended that your child does attend).
