Dear Friends,

I want to take the opportunity for all who have inquired as to how Fr. Jason and I are holding up, given the fact that there are just two priests. I appreciate your sincerity and attentiveness to our needs. As you can imagine, trying to accommodate the needs of 3,500 families is no easy task.

Perhaps, our best response to your inquiries is to say that we are "managing." However, in my opinion, the term "managing" (in this sense) is what I would call an "in-between" term. The response "managing" falls in-between good and bad. In other words, we are doing our best to "manage" almost everything that we have been accustomed to having at Holy Family. We want to do better than just "manage" - we want to make sure that we can give our best in all aspects of ministry.

This summer has provided the opportunity to really look at our parish and look at how we can effectively minister with just two priests and a deacon. This is a large parish, with a lot going on and a lot to cover. Many have asked when we will get another priest. The answer to that is simple, we will not be getting another priest. We are well aware of the reality, there are not enough priests to go around. I think we are blessed to have an associate and a deacon. So, we have to do our best with what we have and, it provides an opportunity to really plan for the future. Many have asked if we foresee dropping a Mass. Right now, I do not foresee us dropping any weekend Masses. Our least populated Mass on a weekend has no less than 400 people at it - that's a lot when you consider many parishes do not have 400 people attending for an entire weekend. However, one of the things we do have to look at is our daily Mass schedule. In those weeks when one of the priests is away, it means the priest at the parish has to do two daily Masses, plus any funerals and weddings. Sometimes this means, that the priest is doing 3 or 4 Masses a day - on top of responding to emergencies and carrying out all of the other pastoral duties of the parish. The last thing you or I want, is to see myself, Fr. Jason or any other priests that may come to Holy Family burned out. I have had many dialogues with our parish council and will continue to do so. One of the things we have to look it is whether or not we can go down to one daily Mass. I will also ask you, our parishioners, for your input on this topic in the very near future.

Again, we want to be able to say we are doing more than just "manage" - we want to be able to give our very best, each and every day, so that all of us, priests, deacon, and holy people of God - can come to know, love and serve the Lord in this life and in the Life to come.

PLEASE NOTE FOR OUR UPCOMING FALL/SPRING SESSION:

FAITH FORMATION WILL NO LONGER BE HELD ON TUESDAY NIGHTS!

The following changes will be made in the upcoming year to improve Faith Formation:

- **Grades K, 1, 3, 4, 5 & 6:** will be offered on Sundays from 10-11:15am and Mondays from 6:15-7:30pm.
- **Grade 2 Faith Formation:** will be offered *only* on Monday nights from 6:15-7:30pm. The sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are taught during Grade 2 and it is necessary that your child is thoroughly prepared. It is highly recommended that if you have a child in Grade 1 that they attend Faith Formation in order to help prepare them for the upcoming Grade 2 Sacramental Preparation year.
- **Grade 7 & 8 Faith Formation:** will be offered on Monday nights *only* in the Church Hall from 6:15-7:30pm. This will be taught using the EDGE ministry curriculum.
- **Confirmation 1** will continue on Sundays from 10-11:30am and **Confirmation 2** will continue on Sundays from 11:45-1:15pm. There will be 3 required masses for C1 and C2 to attend as a group and this is during a class time, with C1 attending mass at 10:30 and C2 attending at the 12:15 mass. If you have a child who attends parochial high school, it is required that they attend the *second* year of Confirmation but, it is not mandatory that they attend Confirmation 1. (though it is highly recommended that your child does attend).
