**A Note from Father Jason on the Indulgence to
be Received on Divine Mercy Sunday
(First Sunday After Easter)**

I would like to share some information from the Holy See about how to gain the indulgence that many seek on Divine Mercy Sunday, which is the Second Sunday of Easter (**the first Sunday after Easter**). There was some confusion last year about the necessary requirements for the receiving of the indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday. Many thought that in order to receive the grace of the indulgence they needed to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation the weekend of Divine Mercy Sunday. This is a misunderstanding. If you read the statements from the Apostolic Penitentiary (which is a Vatican office attached to the Holy See in Rome) regarding the gaining of indulgences, you will notice that it clearly spells out that in order to gain the indulgence you only need to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within 20 days of the particular day on which you seek the indulgence. Which means that if you go to confession 20 days before or 20 days after Divine Mercy Sunday, while fulfilling the other requirements, then you can obtain the indulgence. I hope this is helpful, so that we can avoid the practice of going to confession to “obtain the grace” without actually confessing sins in the confessional.
