This Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. We remember the message of Divine Mercy given to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska by Jesus and the Lord's mercy poured out for us on the cross and now in the sacrament of confession. Here are some excerpts from St. Faustina's diary:

“I am love and mercy Itself. There is no misery that could be a match for My mercy, neither will misery exhaust it, because as it is being granted – it increases. The soul that trusts in My mercy is most fortunate, because I Myself take care of it.” (*Divine Mercy in my Soul* #1273)

“When I see that the burden is beyond my strength, I do not consider or analyze it or probe into it, but I run like a child to the Heart of Jesus and say only one word to Him: “You can do all things.” And then I keep silent, because I know that Jesus Himself will intervene in the matter, and as for me, instead of tormenting myself, I use that time to love Him.” (*Divine Mercy in my Soul* 1033, page 392)

“Great love can change small things into great ones, and it is only love which lends value to our actions. And the purer our love becomes, the less there will be within us for the flames of suffering to feed upon, and the suffering will cease to be a suffering for us; it will become a delight! By the grace of God, I have received such a disposition of heart that I am never so happy as when I suffer for Jesus, whom I love with every beat of my heart.” (*Divine Mercy in my Soul* 303, page 140)
