5 grains: 1 cereal, 1 rice, 1 mac & cheese, 1 pasta
soup: 2 cans
PLUS: 1roll paper towels, 2 rolls toilet paper,
1 dish soap, 1 laundry soap, 1 shampoo,
1 toothpaste, 1 deodorant, 1 bar soap
AND IF AVAILABLE: tea, coffee, snacks, condiments,
flour, sugar, ketchup, mustard, mayonnaise, salad
dressings, cookie & brownie mix.

Fresh produce, bread, bakery items and meats are substituted for canned/boxed items when available
