**PASTOR'S NOTES**

Dear Friends,

Recently, I had the opportunity to update my will (as in my last will and testament). As you may know, that is an interesting exercise. It certainly reminded me of my own mortality, which I hope doesn't happen anytime soon. Going through this process, I had to determine what to do with my assets (possessions, money, dog, etc.). Immediately, I thought about those things that are important to me and what I could do to support them even after I'm gone. I recognized that my family would be okay without any of my belongings or money. There are some charities that are important to me and I would like to help them in the future. Interestingly enough, my thoughts kept coming back to Holy Family Church. I know how special Holy Family is to me and I want it to be special to others in 100 years from now and beyond. In order for that to happen, I decided, in my will, that much of my assets will be given to Holy Family. This is what is important to me – I want our parish family, our church to continue to inspire, motivate, assist and lead people to Christ for many years to come.
