Our Faith ~ Our Family ~ Our Future Capital Campaign

To date, just over 800 families have contributed \$2,616,712 in gifts and pledges to our capital campaign. This is astounding! Already, nearly \$700,000 has been collected and the Diocese has granted us permission to begin some of the work. Recently we signed a contract with a reputable roofer to begin the church flat roof. As you know, the summer is a busy time for roofers, but their hope is to begin the work at the end of August or early September. The same is true of the rectory. Soon, we will be installing all new church doors with automated openers. This will allow us to program when we want our doors to open and close, which will make for a safer, more secure building. On the Chapel Drive side of the church we are looking into what to do with the concrete pad (just outside the main church door). Our hope is to level it somewhat. There would be steps and handicap accessibility as well. This is in the beginning stages at this time. Lastly, in terms of technology upgrades, you will be noticing digital displays in our gathering space and at the church entrances. This will eliminate the need for bulletin boards and clutter and move us into the 21st century with technology. When construction begins, stay tuned to our Facebook page for updates (be sure to check out Fr. Manno's drone footage of the roof construction).
