

**PASTOR'S NOTES**

Dear Friends,

First and foremost, I want to say that I am grateful to Bishop Cunningham for releasing the names of the priests who have a credible allegation of sexual abuse of a minor. It is my sincere prayer that, in releasing these names, it will aid in the healing process for all of the victims of abuse. Please join with me in praying for these victims and their families. As I have mentioned previously, I have had the opportunity to meet several survivors of clergy sexual abuse and their courage, openness, and desire for healing was an inspiration to me and many others. Please keep all victims of abuse of any kind in your prayers.

I have to say that reading the names of the priests on Monday made me very sad. I am sad for the victims and I am sad for the Church. The actions of a few, I am certain, leave all of us questioning, pondering, and wondering about a lot of different things. Even though my heart is sad, I am encouraged by the fact that there has been no credible case of clergy sexual abuse in the Diocese of Syracuse since 1991. Great measures have been taken to make sure these things do not happen. As the Director of Seminarian Formation for the Diocese, I can tell you that our seminarians go through extensive psychological testing prior to entering the seminary and they have very solid human, pastoral, spiritual, and intellectual formation while in the seminary. The Diocese requires that all employees and any volunteer that works with children participate in the VIRTUS program, which requires a background check. Since 2003 over 41,000 employees and volunteers have gone through this program and, those who do so, have to renew every five years. Furthermore, if any allegation of abuse is brought forward, it goes directly to law enforcement – this is so necessary. I am encouraged by this and I can honestly say that here at Holy Family Church and Holy Family School our employees and volunteers are dedicated to protecting our children at all costs. I pray we can work together so that throughout our Diocese there will never ever be another case of abuse.

Lastly, pray for those of us (bishops/priests/deacons) who try our best each day to serve God and to serve others. As you can imagine, this is a difficult time for us. We hurt for the victims and we are extremely saddened by the actions of our brother priests. The Season of Advent gives us hope that Jesus Christ is the light of the world and He comes into the darkness and leads us to his eternal light. So, we put our faith and trust in him and ask him to lead us through this “darkness into his own wonderful light” (1 Peter 2:9).
