Dear Friends,

It is hard to believe that we are already in the season of Lent. I always feel that Lent is such a sacred time in the Church year. Traditionally, the pillars of Lent are prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and sacrifice. There will be numerous opportunities to do all of these things and more. I invite you during this holy season to consider coming to the Stations of the Cross. They are held Friday nights during Lent at 5:30 PM. The Stations of the Cross remind us of "the way" that Jesus walked prior to His crucifixion and death. This beautiful prayer truly reminds us of the love of our Savior.

Many thanks to all who helped with the Lenten Family Mission with Fr. Leo Patalinghug - it was a great success. Fr. Leo brings a message of faith and family life to all of his talks and that is precisely why I decided to bring him to Holy Family. As Fr. Jason so beautifully outlined in his homily last weekend, our vision is to make Holy Family the family parish of the west side and of the whole diocese. All the components are in place with all the ministries we offer to help bolster and promote the true beauty of family life and the connection to faith. One of the great blessings that I see in our parish is the gift of what I call "generational faith." In other words, it is obvious to me to see how faith has been handed down in the families of our parish over generations. For example, one of our kids, at our 4 PM Sunday evening Mass, asked me if I knew their grandpa who went to the Saturday evening 5 PM Mass. I did indeed know his grandpa and it showed that three generations of one family are worshipping here - what a blessing - and I know that is the case in more than one family! So, having Fr. Leo here is the first of many events for family life and fostering the notion that we are a family rooted in faith like the Holy Family of Nazareth and that we are "A Loving Family."

Lastly, Happy Valentine's Day! On this day when we traditionally celebrate love, let's pray that we can recognize God's love in our lives and share that love with all we encounter.

Know of my prayers for a blessed Lent that gives way to the glory of Easter.
