The prophet Micah tells us we are called “to act justly, to love tenderly and to walk humbly with God.” (Micah 6:8). This call includes our service to one another and holds special meaning as we look to the future of our parish.

Most of us have been aware for some time of the steady decline in the number of priests in active ministry in our diocese. Currently there are only 113 active diocesan priests. As this trend continues, the responsibility of supporting and strengthening our parish is ours. As Catholic Christians, our participation and leadership in sacramental preparation, assistance with liturgy, committee membership, teaching our young people, and all aspects of service that create a vibrant parish community are everyone’s sacred responsibility. Our cooperation is crucial.

Since May 2015, representatives from St. Mary’s, Skaneateles; St. Patrick’s, Jordan; St. Michael-St. Peter, Onondaga Hill; St. Francis Xavier, Marcellus; St. Joseph’s, Camillus; Holy Family, Fairmount have been working together to investigate and agree upon new ways that the relationships between our parishes can be strengthened. Those representatives include: the pastors, trustees, and leaders of the pastoral councils. No plans are being made to close or merge parishes. The work that has been done so far is a start at looking at ways we can work, share and cooperate with each other. The insert in today’s bulletin includes the letter of request on behalf of our Pastoral Care Area (PCA) and a letter from Bishop Cunningham approving the recommendations.

Change is never easy, but like the change of seasons it is necessary for growth. We are embarking on a process that will require us to call on our faith, our hope, and our love for our sisters and brothers. We are called to use our gifts and talents for good. We are called to thoughtful prayer. And most importantly, we are called to walk humbly with our God.
