#### **HOPE APPEAL 2017 – By the numbers**

The final numbers are in for the Hope Appeal 2017. Holy Family did well once again thanks to your goodness and generosity. Our goal was \$117,070.24 and we collected in gifts and pledges \$165,114.84. We exceeded our goal by \$48,044.60. This is tremendous – thank you for your support! Since the Diocese has a policy to give half of the overage back, we will receive a check in the near future for \$24,022.30. To date, 827 families out of a possible 3,028 gave to the appeal (27.3%). The average gift to the Hope Appeal per family was \$199.65 (remember we had asked each family to contribute \$175.00). You have made Holy Family Church a leader in the Hope Appeal. More importantly, you will help so many people to encounter Christ through your gift to the appeal. When we give to God and sacrifice on His behalf, He repays us a thousand fold for our goodness!
