Dear Friends,

Over the next month, Msgr. Francis and Fr. Muyo are on vacation. That leaves Fr. Jason, Deacon Bob, and me to cover the sacramental and pastoral needs of our parish. As you know, there is a lot of work here at Holy Family, with two daily Masses and most weeks anywhere from two to five funerals a week - all of this on top of all of our other responsibilities and obligations. In the middle of all of this, Fr. Jason and I will be helping at a neighboring parish for one of our priests that had recent surgery. Father Jason has also been contacted by the bishop to assist him at more Confirmations around the diocese. You may say, "With all that the Holy Family priests are doing, why don't they get another priest to assist with those other parishes?" The reality is simple; we don't have a lot of additional help when it comes to priests. Even our retired priests and the religious order priests assisting in our Diocese are stretched thin. Some of our retired priests are saying three Masses a day just to help those of us still working to get some time off and rest.

Over the next month, while we may be busy here at Holy Family, I truly believe that it is a good time for us to evaluate how we will operate, as a parish, with fewer priests. I have said many times that the day will come when we are just a two-priest parish (I hope the day never comes when we are a one priest parish). We need to be ready for that day. Therefore, with Msgr. Francis and Fr. Muyo away, we will evaluate our needs and how we can best serve our parish as we go forward. In the meantime, I ask for your prayers for your priests (us here and all priests throughout the Diocese). It is common for Fr. Jason and me to put in 12-16 hour days most days of the week - oftentimes working on our day off to ensure the needs of the parish are met. While we are not adverse to working hard, we also know it is not healthy spiritually, physically, and emotionally. We would like to be around for many years to come and in order for that to happen we know that we will have to make some changes to our schedules. So, keep us in your prayers and know that you are in our daily prayers.

Please join me in praying for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. We need more young men and women to respond to God's call to Church service as priests, deacons, and religious brothers and sisters. I feel there are many vocations out there (even in our pews at Holy Family), so let's be sure to encourage, foster, and promote vocations here in our parish family.
