PARISH MISSION AT ST. PATRICK'S, JORDAN

St. Patrick's Church in Jordan is hosting a Parish Mission from February 24 – 26, 2020. The mission is being given by Rev. Kevin O'Neill, C.S.S.R. a Redemptorist priest from New Jersey. Fr. O'Neill has given many parish retreats and is a phenomenal speaker. All from Holy Family are invited to attend. The theme for the mission is: *Change our Hearts: Our Lenten Prayer*. On Monday, February 24 at 7:00 PM the theme will be, *Change our Hearts*. Construction Update

Due to the mild weather in January, great progress has been made on the new parish rectory. The roof and windows are in making the house ready for the inside work.

Currently, the house is being heated on the inside so as to allow the pouring of the concrete slab in the basement. Once that is completed, the framing of the lower level will take place and then all of the electrical, plumbing, heating, air conditioning, and finish work can begin. The completion date is slated for some time in May 2020. Once the house is done, the priests will move in and the demolition of the old rectory and repaving of the parking lot will take place. This will give us much more parking! Thank you for your sacrifices and your great generosity in making this project a reality!

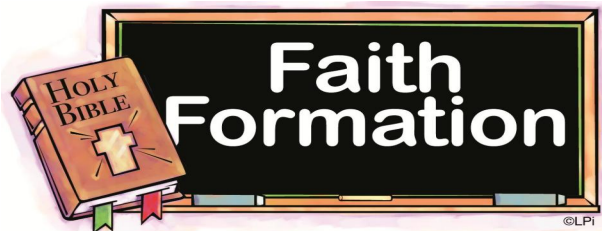
