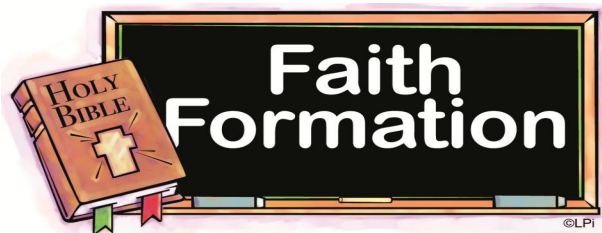

Turn the channel, turn off the television, or walk out of the movie theater when you hear God's name taken in vain, which has become all too frequent. Vow never to take the Lord's name in vain and to make reparation immediately if you accidentally do or if you hear someone else do so. How can you make reparation? Or pray the Golden Arrow Prayer in reparation for blasphemies against His Most Holy Name.
