**PASTOR'S NOTES**

Dear Friends,

This past Friday, January 19, Fr. Lyons and I, along with 45 young people and chaperones from our parish had the opportunity to attend the annual March for Life in Washington, DC. It was a wonderful opportunity to march with over 400,000 people and offer a peaceful, prayerful protest of abortion and all issues that go against the sanctity and dignity of human life.

Looking back, I realize that I have participated in this national march almost twenty (20) times. One thing that always amazes me is that I am an "old man" at the march as the average age is around 17/18 years young. It truly is inspiring to see the number of young people at the march and to witness their enthusiasm and zeal for life. On Friday morning Bishop Cunningham offered a Mass for nearly 500 people from the Diocese of Syracuse that attended the March for Life. The Mass was held at the National Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Washington. Again, most of the 500 people were young people! It is so uplifting and inspiring to see our young people stand up for life.

Pope Francis often says that we live in a "throw away culture" and what is often thrown out first is life. Let's pray as a community of faith that our thoughts, our words, our deeds will always be life giving and not life threatening. Let's pray for an end to abortion in our country and throughout the world and for an end to all acts that disregard life or see it as merely disposable. All life is sacred and beautiful because it is indeed a gift from a loving creator!
