In addition to my responsibilities as pastor of our beautiful parish, I have the privilege of serving our diocese as the Diocesan Director of Seminarians. Each semester I have to travel to the four seminaries that we use – in New York City, Boston, Washington, DC, and Baltimore. I meet with the seminarians and their priest advisors and then report to the Bishop on the progress of each seminarian. I can tell you in all honesty that we are blessed with a good group of men studying for the priesthood. Please pray that more will come forward!

As you pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life. I encourage vou to pray more for men to consider the permanent diaconate. The Diocese of Syracuse is blessed with many permanent deacons. Our parish has been blessed with permanent deacons throughout the years. Most recently, Deacon Nick Alvaro (now administrator in Oswego, NY) and Deacon Bob Fangio have been tremendous assets to our community. We could not do all that we do without the help of our deacons. Deacon Bob, in addition to all of his liturgical help, trains our altar servers, lectors, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, helps to coordinate our Young at Heart Group, is a member of our Life Teen Core Team, assists with our evangelization efforts, plays the accordion at the 4 PM Mass, is the assistant Diocesan Director of Permanent Deacon Personnel, and a dentist at the dental clinic at the Cathedral. Of course all of this is done in addition, to being a husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle and so on. We need our deacon(s). Furthermore, we are blessed at Holy Family because on Saturday, May 19, 2018, Scott Harris, one of our parishioners, will be ordained a permanent deacon at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception.
