Dear Friends,

I know we are all grateful for the great work and ministry of Msgr. Francis and Fr. Muyo and your goodness last week demonstrated your love and thankfulness to both of them! Now, we pray for them and ask God's continual blessing on their travels and ministry!

Many of you have been asking if there will be another priest or priests to assist us at Holy Family. The answer is simple... "no." The reality in our diocese is that there are not enough priests to go around. There are parishes in our diocese that do not even have one priest, so we need to be really thankful for the fact that we have two priests and a deacon. Many of you have been asking, "How will you be able to do everything with just two priests?" I think that is a legitimate question and a very good question to which I can only give the following answer.... "We cannot do everything that we have been accustomed to doing with just two priests." In previous columns, I have shared with you that Fr. Jason and I each put in 60-80 hours a week. Most days are 12-16 hour days for us. Anyone will tell you we are hard workers and love what we do. But, at the same time, I have to be concerned about what happens when you try to put in 60-80 hours a week, every week. It leads to burnout, stress, depression, frustration, sickness, and so on. Priests are no different from anyone else - we can only do so much. I want to ensure that Fr. Jason and I will be around for many years, and in order to do that, we need to take the appropriate steps now. I have been in dialogue with our Pastoral Council to ensure that we can continue to provide the best possible service to our parish without overburdening the priests and deacon. So, at the recommendation of our Pastoral Council, for the time being we will have only one daily Mass on national holidays at 9:00 AM (July 4 - Independence Day, September 5 - Labor Day, October 10 - Columbus Day, November 11 - Veterans Day, Thursday, November 24 - Thanksgiving Day and Friday, November 25 - the day after Thanksgiving). Also, there will be no confessions on Wednesdays from 6:30-7:30 PM. There will always be confessions on Saturday before the Vigil Mass from 3:30 to 4:45 PM and by appointment. Destiny USA has confessions daily. In short, there will only be one Mass on national holidays and no confessions on Wednesday evenings.

I can only ask for your patience and understanding as we go through this transition. I know change is not easy for anyone (priests included). I ask for your prayers for Fr. Jason, Deacon Bob, and me as we go through this time. We will give our parish "everything we got" as they say, but within reason. We need to make sure we take care of ourselves so we can take care of the spiritual needs of our parish. Please know that you are in our prayers and we ask that you pray for us daily!

FAITH FORMATION WILL NO LONGER BE HELD ON TUESDAY NIGHTS!

The following changes will be made in the upcoming year to improve Faith Formation:

- Grades K, 1, 3, 4, 5, & 6: will be offered on Sundays from 10 – 11:15AM and Mondays from 6:15-7:30PM
- Grade 2 Faith Formation: will be offered only on Monday nights from 6:15 – 7:30PM. The sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are taught during Grade 2 and it is necessary that your child is thoroughly prepared. It is highly recommended that if you have a child in Grade 1 that they attend Faith Formation in order to help prepare them for the upcoming Grade 2 Sacramental Preparation year.
- Grade 7 & 8 Faith Formation: will be offered on Monday nights only in the church hall from 6:15 – 7:30PM. This will be taught using the EDGE ministry curriculum.
- Confirmation 1 will continue on Sundays from 10 -11:30AM and Confirmation 2 will continue on Sundays from 11:45AM – 1:15PM. There will be 3 required Masses for C1 and C2 to attend as a group and this is during a class time, with C1 attending Mass at 10:30AM and C2 attending at the 12:15PM Mass. If you have a child who attends parochial high school, it is required that they attend the second year of Confirmation but, it is not mandatory that they attend Confirmation 1. (Though it is highly recommended that your child does attend).
