January 22 Day of Prayer**For the Legal Protection of unborn Children**

The over 56 million abortions since the 1973 decisions of Roe v Wade reflect with heartbreaking magnitude what Pope Francis means by a "throwaway culture." However, we have great trust in God's providence. We are reminded time and again in Scripture to seek the Lord's help, and as people of faith, we believe that our prayers are heard.

Therefore, every year on the anniversary of this unjust decision, the Catholic Church designated January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, call the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children, and "In all the Dioceses of the United States, January 22 shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion."

As individuals, we can observe this day by offering up our Communion for this intention, spending an hour before the Blessed Sacrament, a rosary with family or group, fasting, and/or participating in any of the special events planned to observe the anniversary of Roe v Wade.

A great prayer for life is urgently needed, a prayer which will rise up throughout the world...may an impassioned plea rise to God, the Creator and lover of life, from every Christian community, from every group and association, from every family and from the heart of every believer. (Pope Saint John Paul II)
