BAPTISM CLASS

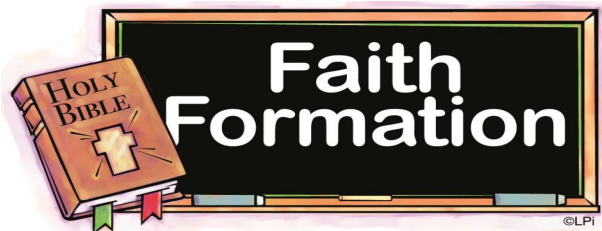
