On Friday, January 18 nearly 300,000 people participated in the annual March for Life in Washington, DC. It is a prayerful, peaceful protest to stand up for life and the sacredness of human life from conception until natural death. Since 1973, abortion has been legalized in our country, and, we pray that one day soon it will be overturned.

While we pray for an end to abortion nationally, right here in New York State, legislation is being considered to expand abortion. According to the New York State Catholic Conference, "The Governor and legislative leaders have promised to pass a dangerous proposal called the "Reproductive Health Act" early in the 2019 legislative session. The bill has now been introduced and it is numbered S.240 and A.21. It would eliminate New York's current restrictions on late-term abortion, empower non-doctors to perform abortions, remove protections against unwanted or coerced abortions, and even legalize infanticide of live born infants." As a prolife people we are called to take a stand against this type of legislation.

If you do not have those resources or would rather write directly to your representatives, please do so. Anything we can do to let our voice be heard is so necessary. Remember, it is not just our voice, it is the voices of unborn children that have no one to advocate for them. We are their advocates and we are their voice.

Thank you in advance for your consideration of this request and let's pray that the Holy Family of Nazareth, Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, will inspire all in the world to work to promote the sanctity and dignity of human life! I thank God everyday for the gift of my life and your life!






