WE NEED YOUR HELP!

The recent cuts in the Federal Budget have impacted our food pantry in a very significant way. A large part of the pantry operating budget are the grant monies that we receive from Central New York Food Bank. These grants allow us to purchase food from the food bank at a much lower price than we would have to pay in any store. Because we serve such a large population each month, this is a huge savings for us. As of July 1, 2017, our grants from the Central New York Food Bank have been suspended, until at least November. We were granted a small amount of money by the Food Bank as an extension on the 2016-2017 GRANT. We are being told that the Food Bank will let us know whether we will be granted our grant money for 2018.
