PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Friends,

"I give thanks to my God at every remembrance of you, praying always with joy in my every prayer for all of you..." (Philippians 1:3-4). These words come to mind as I think of the great generosity of our parish community. I think of the

great sacrifices you make from week to week of your time, talent, and treasure and I am filled with an overwhelming sense of gratitude. At the same time, I am grateful for your goodness to the annual Hope Appeal. Currently, we have raised just over \$100,000 of our goal of \$117,000. I am confident we will meet our goal. However, I am concerned that only 16% of our parish has given to this appeal. Roughly, 560 families out of a possible 3,500 have given to the annual Hope Appeal. As I have shared with you, the Hope Appeal really allows us to bring Jesus to others. Through our generosity we provide scholarships to families for Catholic education, support Catholic television, Mass for shut-ins, hospital chaplains, college chaplains, evangelization programs, catechetical programs, youth and young adult programs, food pantries, soup kitchens, and so much more. Imagine how many people could encounter Jesus if we all get behind this appeal. Let's make this a parish effort, a Holy Family Parish effort and truly get involved in this appeal. If you are part of the 16% of our parish that has given to the appeal, I thank you for your generosity and support. If you are part of the 84% that has yet to make a gift or pledge, I strongly encourage you to make your gift or pledge as soon as possible. Your gift, your charity, will go a long way in helping someone to know, love, and serve the Lord. I pray with sincere gratitude for the gift of the sacrifices you make daily for our parish. I pray that the Holy Family of Nazareth, Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, will bless us to be generous, cheerful givers and, in doing so, I know God will repay us a hundredfold.
