Simply, the Hope Appeal brings Jesus to others. Throughout our seven county diocese Jesus is revealed and we help to make that possible through our generous sharing of our resources. The Hope Appeal reveals Jesus by helping to subsidize food pantries, soup kitchens, homeless shelters, providing Catholic School tuition assistance, the Mass for shut-ins, The Catholic Sun newspaper, family life initiatives, pro-life activities, faith formation programs, youth and young adult programs, vocation promotion, seminary formation, hospital and nursing home chaplains, and the list goes on and on. By supporting the Hope Appeal you make these much needed ministries in our diocese a reality.

Every parish has a Hope Appeal goal. Our goal is \$117,000. In an effort to raise that goal, I am respectfully asking every family to consider a minimum gift of \$175.00 (\$.48 a day or \$14.58 a month). If you can afford more than the minimum gift, I encourage you to give what your heart compels you to give. If you cannot afford the minimum gift, give what you are able to give because every gift counts. Remember, a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family. If we exceed our goal of \$117,000, half of the overage comes back to us for our use. As of today 270 families of a possible 3,500 have made contributions to the Hope Appeal – that’s 7% of our parish family. If you have not made your gift or pledge, please do so as soon as possible. There are envelopes around the church for you to use. Imagine what it would be like if we had 100% participation from our parish – we could really do great things for the Lord.

To all who have contributed thus far, thank you for your great goodness. To those who have not contributed as of yet, thank you in advance for your generosity. Your goodness will be a blessing to so many. Thank you to all of you for the sacrifices you make on behalf of Holy Family. You are an inspiration and blessing to me and so many others.

I am happy to say that we have 2 blessings to share with you this week!

1. We have a new Pantry volunteer. His name is Stan. He is a parishioner of St. Daniel's and is involved in several ministries there. But we are so lucky that he also has time to come and help us too. We now have an awesome, dedicated staff of 10, not counting all of our wonderful volunteer drivers.

2. We received a letter on June 4th confirming that we have been approved for the 2018-2019 McDevitt Food Pantry Grant in the amount of \$4,565.45. We are truly blessed to receive this grant, as it is a large part of the Outreach Operating budget. There were many more applicants this year, due to the Federal cuts in the Feeding America Program, so we are truly grateful for this blessing.

THE CHURCH BASEMENT WILL BE CLOSED FOR 2 WEEKS FOR THE ANNUAL FLOOR STRIPPING AND WAXING, SO THIS MEANS THAT THE PANTRY WILL BE CLOSED AS WELL. WE WILL HAVE SOME CARTS AVAILABLE FOR PANTRY DONATIONS, AND THERE WILL BE EMERGENCY FOOD AVAILABLE, SHOULD THE NEED ARISE.
