Dear Friends,

Several years ago, our parish conducted a successful capital campaign to raise money for improvements in the church, the shrine, the offices, and rectory. To date, the work has been done in the church and shrine and we will begin work on the offices beginning June 26, 2017 (work on the rectory will wait to a later date as we still are determining the best course of action).

Effective, Monday, June 26 our parish offices will be relocated to the Sister’s Convent, just down the road on Chapel Drive. The Sister’s have graciously opened their doors as our offices are being renovated. While the offices are being renovated, nobody will have access to the building. Even the Adoration Chapel will be closed. One of our goals for the chapel is to make it sound proof and make sure that the heat and air conditioning will get to that space. For those who utilize the adoration chapel – you are more than welcome to utilize the church, which is open from early in the morning till evening time. For nocturnal adoration on First Friday’s we will be using the multi-purpose room for adoration. Please make note of this change.

For Mass cards and other office needs our staff will take care of those things at the convent. I can only beg for your patience and understanding as we go through this process. It will take 8-12 weeks of construction and then we will have a grand opening. I can assure you it will be beautiful when it is completed. In our renovated space we will host our parish offices, our Adoration Chapel, the Gianna Clinic and John Paul II Center, the downstairs will have handicap accessibility, and much more. This project is long overdue and we are most grateful for your cooperation, generosity, and understanding.

Thank you for making Holy Family a blessed and loving parish.
