HOPE APPEAL 2018

Did you know that the monies generated in the annual Hope Appeal support: Catholic Charities, Catholic Schools, Family Life programs, evangelization efforts throughout the diocese, pro-life programs, vocation promotion, deacon formation, catechetical efforts, soup kitchens, food pantries, homeless shelters, the weekly Mass for shut-ins, college Newman Centers, hospital and nursing home chaplains, jail ministry, youth and young adult events, and so much more? Did you know that as a result of your generosity and goodness to the Hope Appeal, over 250,000 people throughout our seven county Diocese are impacted? Your goodness helps reveal Jesus to others. Every parish has a Hope Appeal goal. Our goal at Holy Family is \$117,000. In an effort to raise our goal, I am respectfully requesting every family in the parish to consider a minimum gift of \$175.00 – that’s \$.48 a day or \$14.58 a month. If you can afford more than the minimum gift, give what you are able to give. If you cannot afford the minimum gift, give something – every gift counts. Remember, a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family in the sense that our parish benefits from the Hope Appeal. First, our food pantry receives a grant from the Hope Appeal each year to help us buy much needed food for our pantry. Secondly, if we exceed our goal, half of the overage comes back to the parish for our use. Last year, Holy Family received a check from the Hope Appeal Office for \$23,000, which was half of our overage. Please make your gift or pledge as soon as possible. If you received an envelope from the Diocese of Syracuse – you can use that. In addition, there are envelopes in all of the pews and at all of the church doors. You can drop your gift or pledge in the collection basket, drop it off at the parish office, or mail it directly to the address on the envelope. There is an option for online giving at syracusediocese.org. Thank you so much for your tremendous generosity. It truly is a testimony of the faith you possess. The Hope Appeal allows Jesus to be revealed to so many throughout our area and this can only happen due to your generosity. Thank you for bringing God to so many through your selfless giving and the sacrifices you make. God will repay us all a hundredfold for our goodness.
