PASTOR’S NOTES

Dear Friends,

My sincerest thanks to all who have contributed to the annual Hope Appeal so far. We know that the Hope Appeal funds so many wonderful ministries in the Diocese of Syracuse. The Hope Appeal supports, hospital chaplaincy, college chaplains, Catholic school tuition assistance, Faith formation, youth ministry, evangelization efforts, Mass for shut-ins, food pantries, soup kitchens, Catholic Charities, and so much more. Also, a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family, as our parish benefits from the Hope Appeal.

Every parish has an assessment for the Hope Appeal. Our assessment is \$117,000. In an effort to meet our assessment I am asking every family in the parish to consider a minimum gift of \$175 (\$14.58 a month or \$.48 a day). I know it is a sacrifice, but it is one worth making. If you cannot afford the minimum gift, give what you can – every gift counts! If you can afford more than the minimum gift, please give with your heart moves you to give. Last year 23% of the parish contributed to the appeal, imagine if 30% or 40% gave – it would be a great success. If we meet and exceed our goal of \$117,000 then half of the overage comes back to our parish for our use. Thank you from the bottom of my heart for all the sacrifices you make on behalf of our parish and thank you for helping to ensure that the overage Hope Appeal will be a great success at Holy Family Church.

The Syracuse Diocese is home to a network of practitioners and doctors who specialize in a system of authentic women's health care known as the Creighton Model Fertility Care System. This system empowers women and couples to gain vital information about their health and fertility. It can be used for natural family planning as well as the diagnosis and treatment of infertility and various other women's health issues. Women of all reproductive ages are encouraged to explore this system as a means of better understanding and monitoring their own health as well as appreciating the great gift of their fertility. For couples, it is an effective and fulfilling means of building their families in a manner that is in complete conformity with Catholic Church teaching. (Method effectiveness rate for avoiding pregnancy is 99.5%, and success rates for overcoming infertility are equal to or greater than that of In Vitro Fertilization.) Free Introductory Sessions of the Creighton Model Fertility Care System are held every second Tuesday of the month at Holy Family Parish (127 Chapel Drive, Syracuse NY) from September through May and by appointment June through August.
