PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Friends,

Late last week, I was informed that Bishop Moynihan, our retired bishop, was not doing well and in need of prayers. Early on Monday, March 6, Bishop Moynihan was called home to God. I had the opportunity to get to know Bishop Moynihan quite well as he was the one that ordained me to the priesthood. Please keep Bishop Moynihan in your prayers. One of his priorities while serving in our diocese was to increase vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Please join me in prayer for an increase in vocations as we remember Bishop Moynihan and the great work he did in the Diocese of Syracuse. Eternal rest grant unto him O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace. Amen!

Here are a few other things for your consideration...

- We received permission from the Diocese to proceed with our office renovation. That work will begin in May/June 2017. We are looking forward to creating a warm, welcoming pastoral center (parish office) for our parish.
- We are continuing our efforts to slow traffic on Chapel Drive and through our parking lots. Please be mindful that the speed limit on Chapel Drive is 15 MPH. Our goal as a parish and school community should be to ensure safety for all. In our parking lots the speed limit should be no more than 5-10 MPH. - DISPENSATION HAS BEEN GRANTED BY OUR BISHOP for St. Patrick's Day. St. Patrick's Day falls on a Friday this year and Bishop Cunningham has granted the faithful throughout the Diocese of Syracuse a dispensation from abstinence. Please see the information below. Might I suggest that if you are going to have your corned beef on St. Patrick's Day, you find another day of the week to abstain from eating meat. Dispensation: As March 17, 2017, the Feast of St. Patrick falls on a Friday during Lent, Bishop Cunningham grants a dispensation from abstinence. At the same time, Bishop Cunningham reminds all priests that they should instruct their faithful of the need for fasting and abstaining from meat on Good Friday, and to abstain on the other Fridays of Lent.
