A Note from Father Jason on the Indulgence to be Received on Divine Mercy Sunday:

I would like to share some information from the Holy See about how to gain the indulgence that many seek on Divine Mercy Sunday, which is the Second Sunday after Easter. There was some confusion last year about the necessary requirements for the receiving of the indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday. Many thought that in order to receive the grace of the indulgence they needed to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation the weekend of Divine Mercy Sunday. This is a misunderstanding. Please read the notes below taken from the Apostolic Penitentiary, which is an office attached to the Holy See, regarding the gaining of indulgences. You will notice that it clearly spells out that in order to gain the indulgence you only need to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within 20 days of the particular day on which you seek the indulgence. Which means that if you went to confession 20 days before or 20 days after, while fulfilling the other requirements, then you can obtain the indulgence. I hope this is helpful, so that we can avoid the practice of going to confession to "obtain the grace" without actually confessing sins in the confessional. Please read the notes below from the Vatican:

A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day. In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace:

Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; have sacramentally confessed their sins; receive the Holy Eucharist; pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.

It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act. Prayer for the Pope's intentions is left to the choice of the faithful, but an "Our Father" and a "Hail Mary" are suggested. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence. Indulgences can always be applied either to oneself or to the souls of the deceased, but they cannot be applied to other persons living on earth.
