***PASTOR'S NOTES***

Dear Friends,

Recently, a new young family from our parish asked me, "Where can I take my son when he is crying at Church and I need to step away for a few moments to calm him?" I thought that was a legitimate question and one that many of our young families may ask. For the past year and a half, Fr. Jason and I have made sure that our multi-purpose room, or as it was called in the past, our crying room, is family friendly. That room is located right off the gathering area in the back of the church and is available for, and its primary use is for families that may need to bring their child somewhere for a few moments. Ultimately, we want all of our children to be in the church and worship and pray with all of us. However, as an uncle of 18 nieces and nephews and a great uncle to two adorable children, I know there are times when there might be a need to take the child to the crying room. Please know that room is for all families for those times when it is needed!

On another note, a **DISPENSATION HAS BEEN GRANTED BY OUR BISHOP** for St. Patrick's Day. St. Patrick's Day falls on a Friday this year and Bishop Cunningham has granted the faithful throughout the Diocese of Syracuse a dispensation from abstinence. Please see the information below. Might I suggest that if you are going to have your corned beef on St. Patrick's Day that you find another day of the week to abstain from eating meat.

***Dispensation: As March 17, 2017, the Feast of St. Patrick falls on a Friday during Lent, Bishop Cunningham grants a dispensation from abstinence. At the same time, Bishop Cunningham reminds all priests that they should instruct their faithful of the need for fasting and abstaining from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and to abstain on the other Fridays of Lent.***
