PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Friends,

So often I find myself asking what more I can do to bring Jesus to others. While I know I cannot do everything, I still wish I could do more. That is why the annual Hope Appeal in the Diocese of Syracuse is so important to me. Through our generosity to the Hope Appeal we empower others to bring Jesus to so many people.

I am always amazed by the fact that the Hope Appeal touches so many lives. Hope Appeal money is used to provide college chaplains, Mass on television for our shut-ins, hospital and nursing home chaplains, Catholic school tuition assistance, to enhance faith formation and youth ministry programs, vocation promotion, Catholic Television, evangelization, food pantries, soup kitchens, and so much more. At Holy Family, we benefit from the Hope Appeal because if we exceed our goal, half of the overage comes back to us for our use. **A gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family.**

This weekend I ask you to please consider your gift to the Hope Appeal. In an effort to meet our goal of \$117,000, I am asking every family in the parish to consider a gift of \$175.00 (\$.48 a day or \$14.58 a month). If you can give more than the minimum gift, please give what your heart compels you to give. If you cannot give the minimum gift, please give what you are able to give – every gift counts. I know I am asking you to make a sacrifice and I want you to know that I would never ask you to do something that I would not do. I personally have made a gift to the Hope Appeal for \$2,500.00. The results of Hope Appeal 2016...

Every year the Diocese of Syracuse publishes the results of the Hope Appeal from the previous year. Holy Family did very well in our Hope Appeal campaign last year.

In the category of total amount received, Holy Family was second (2nd) in the diocese...we raised \$165,703.21. Holy Cross Church, DeWitt was first as they raised \$297,705.00.

In the category of percentage of goal received, Holy Family was fourth (4th) in the diocese...we raised 142.27% of our goal. Holy Cross Church, DeWitt was first (243.95 % of their goal), St. Anthony, Syracuse was second (186.83% of their goal), St. James, Syracuse was third (162.91% of their goal).

In the category of number of households participating, Holy Family was first (1st) with 875 households making gifts or pledges to the Hope Appeal. Holy Cross, DeWitt was second (2nd) with 616 households participating.

The one area we have to do better in is the percentage of parishioners that gave to the Hope Appeal...we had 875 families out of a possible 3,500 families contribute to the Hope Appeal. Therefore, only 25% of our parish supported the Hope Appeal. Imagine how we could touch many lives if 30% or 40% or 50% of our parish participated.
