**HOPE APPEAL 2018**

In just a couple of weeks we will kick off the Hope Appeal 2018 campaign here at Holy Family Church. For the past two years Holy Family has been a leader in the Hope Appeal. This year we will be asking for your generosity once again. The Hope Appeal allows so many fruitful ministries to take place in our seven county diocese. It supports our Catholic Schools, Youth and Young Adult programs, catechetical programs, food pantries, soup kitchens, Catholic Charities.

counseling services, pro-life services and programs, and so much more. Every parish in the diocese has a goal, our goal at Holy Family is \$117,000 – the same as it has been for the past three years. Last year we raised nearly \$165,000 due to your great generosity. As we have done for the past three years, I am asking every family to consider a minimum gift of \$175.00 (that's \$14.58 a month or \$.48 a day). Last year, the average gift of our parishioners was just over \$200. If you can give more than the minimum gift, I encourage you to do so, if you cannot give the minimum gift, give what you can as every gift counts. I would never ask you to do something that I would not do – my annual gift to the Hope Appeal is \$2,500.00 because I believe in the good it accomplishes in our diocese. It is a sacrifice for me, as I know it is for you, but one worth making. Remember, if we exceed our goal of \$117,000, half of the overage comes back to our parish for our use. In March the Diocese of Syracuse sent a check for \$23,000 (half of our overage), that is being used to increase security on our campus, in our office, school, and church buildings. Also, we will use some of that money to increase technology so we can provide more opportunities for our parish. Simply put, a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family as well! The Hope Appeal allows us to bring Jesus to so many. Thank you in advance for your generosity and goodness. I pray that the Lord blesses all of us in abundance for our generosity and our willingness to bring Him to others!
