PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Friends.

I hope you had a blessed Thanksgiving! Now that we are full and well fed we can look forward to Advent and Christmas.

This past week we had our monthly Pastoral Council Meeting and I am most grateful for their support, feedback, and guidance that they offer on so many different topics that impact our parish. At this meeting we discussed many issues from maintenance needs to pastoral needs in our parish. We had the opportunity to walk through the renovated Pastoral Center and all agreed that it is beautiful and the renovations were much needed. You will have the opportunity to see the space in the very near future. We talked about other maintenance needs like our roofs on the church and school and our parking lots. The roofs on the church and school are well over 20 years old and are in need of repair and replacing. We have to plan for these things now as opposed to later. The same is true of our parking lots. In a few years or so they will all have to be resurfaced, which, as you can imagine, is a big project. The Pastoral Council has asked me to make the rectory the first priority. Over the next few months we will be looking into the feasibility of building a new rectory right next to where the current one (just to the left of the current rectory). There is no time frame for when construction would start as there is a lot to consider. It is the hope of the council that this project be done sooner than later. I will keep all of you updated as we move through this process. In addition, we talked about planning for the future with fewer priests and what this means to Holy Family and our area. It is a reality that we have to plan for now so as to ensure that all the needs of our parish can be met well into the future. Just so you know, our average Mass attendance at Holy Family during the month of October was 4,800. So, over our six Masses on the weekend we saw nearly 5,000 people. Lastly, the safety of each of our parishioners came up in light of events in Texas and elsewhere. A subcommittee will be formed to ensure that we can do all that we can to keep each other safe at all times. More information will follow on this as well.

As you can see, there is a lot going on and a lot to discuss. Thank you for your support and goodness in supporting all that we do as a parish family. May the Holy Family of Nazareth, Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, pray for us daily!

MARK YOUR CALENDARS

Christmas Eve/Day: Sunday, December 24 – Christmas Eve Masses at 4, 6, 8, and 12 Midnight. Monday, December 25, 2017 – Masses at 7:30, 9:30, and 11:30 AM.


