Dear Friends,

On Monday I had the opportunity to attend our Pastoral Care Area (PCA) Meeting (along with Fr. Lyons, Malachi Clark, and Ed Campagna). The PCA is a group of parishes set up by the Diocese of Syracuse to work together in planning for the future, especially with fewer priests. Our PCA consists of us, St. Joseph's Church, Camillus, St. Patrick's, Jordan, St. Mary's, Skaneateles, St. Michael/St. Peter, Onondaga Hill, and St. Francis Xavier, Marcellus. This PCA has been working together for the last two years (I can only speak about my time with this group) on ways that we can work together to provide the best care for our people.

Here is the reality the PCA will have to deal with – fewer priests going forward. As you know with fewer priests, it means that more will be asked of our priests that will be left behind and we can only ask so much of a few without running the risk of burnout. This will move us to work together with our neighboring parishes and we have been doing that in so many beautiful ways already. Our church and St. Joseph's in Camillus have coordinated our daily Mass schedules, holy day Mass schedules, shared penance services, combined our choirs on several occasions, and so on. In a short period of time, we have done quite a bit. This continued cooperation among our parishes is so essential and necessary.

Thank you for your support and goodness. One of the things we all know (but don't always like) is that change is inevitable. I am most grateful to God that we have an associate priest and another priest to help us at Holy Family. I am also smart enough to know that won't last forever. So, we can enjoy it while we have it and we must prepare for the day when it will be gone. Pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life and pray asking God what you can do to help build up His Kingdom right here at Holy Family.
