**PASTOR'S NOTES**

Dear Friends,

One of my roles as pastor is to constantly work to ensure that our buildings and grounds are cared for and properly maintained. This is a loft task when you consider that square footage of our buildings. While our campus is not all that big, most of it is occupied with buildings and parking lots and these things need ongoing routine maintenance – just as you do for your own homes. We are so blessed here at Holy Family to have good proactive people who know our buildings and grounds and work to make sure they are kept up. I am grateful to our maintenance crew, our Buildings and Grounds Committee, and all who help to oversee our campus. We work together to ensure the property is maintained.

As is the case in your homes, there is always work to be done. This weekend we are doing a repair job to the parking lot. I know it is in inconvenience, but it is necessary. The repairs will be done over a three-day period and I ask for your patience. In a parish our size, there is never a good time to do such things, but if we do not do these things, it only gets worse and costs more. The parking lot project is one of several that we need to look at in the near future. Another project we are looking at is our playground, located just outside of our school building. The playground is a wood structure that needs to be replaced with new metal/hard plastic structure. On the weekend of November 5<sup>th</sup> we will have a second collection and ask for your generous support of this project. In addition, we have to consider the fact that our church, now 21 years old, has some issues we need to review. Things like the flat roofs on our church have a life span of 20 years, our sidewalks and our sound system have all outlived their normal life span. Lastly, as I have mentioned before, we have some significant issues with our rectory. As a parish we need to have a real conversation whether to repair or replace it. To this end, we will be having a Listening Session, sponsored by our Parish Pastoral Council, on Thursday, October 19 at 6:30 PM in the church. This listening session will serve as an opportunity for me to share with you the issues with the rectory and receive your feedback as to how to proceed as a parish community. I hope you can make it to this session.

Thank you for taking the opportunity to read through this information, it is a lot. I know that all of you, like me, are proud to call Holy Family your spiritual home and I know we are all committed to ensuring that it will be around for years to come!
