Dear Friends,

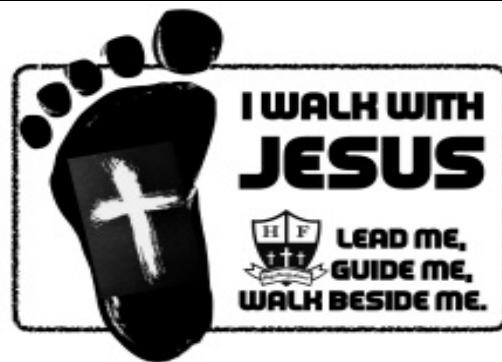
