Dear Friends,

Sunday, October 9 was a day for all of us to celebrate at Holy Family. One of our parishioners, Edward Terzolo, was formally commissioned as a lay minister at the Cathedral and, another parishioner, Scott Harris, participated in the Rite of Candidacy for Permanent Deacons at the Cathedral (meaning that he has formally accepted the call to be ordained a permanent deacon for our diocese).

Congratulations to both Edward and Scott. Furthermore, Scott will be ordained a deacon in just two years, Edward Terzolo and Ricardo Suarez of our parish are just starting out in the formation program to be ordained permanent deacons. This formation program is a six year program, the first two years are spent in the Formation for Ministry program run by our Diocese and the last four years are spent preparing to be ordained a deacon. It is a true blessing that our parish has three men in formation for the permanent diaconate. Please keep them in your prayers that they may always listen and respond to God's call in their lives.

On another note...after months of preparation, consultation and prayer, the Diocese of Syracuse is about to embark on a capital campaign that will raise the necessary funds to restore the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. Our Cathedral is the centerpiece of our Diocese and the Mother Church of our Diocese. We have a shared responsibility to assist in this important fundraising effort. Over the next several weeks you will learn by way of the bulletin and by way of announcements of how you can help in this great work of restoring our Cathedral. The Cathedral building is over 100 years old and is need of a new roof, repointing of the brick, stained glass window restoration, and so much more. It is important that we all get behind this great restoration project to ensure for years to come the opportunity for many to enjoy our Cathedral and its presence in the heart of the city of Syracuse.

Hope Appeal 2016 By the Numbers

Here is the latest update on our 2016 Hope Appeal at Holy Family. Our parish goal was \$117,842.97 and, as of today, we have raised 138.76% of our goal. In total we have raised in gifts and pledges \$163,519.21. This is absolutely amazing. Currently, 842 families out of 2,966 have made gifts or pledges – that's roughly 28.39% of our parish. We are fourth in the Diocese of Syracuse in what we have raised above our goal. The average gift or pledge to the Hope Appeal at Holy Family is \$194.20.
