



Construction Update

Church Flat Roof – completed this past week.

This project was the main priority of our Capital Campaign and it is a blessing that it has been completed before the weather changes.

Church Doors – New church doors will be installed soon. They will have the technology to be controlled remotely by computer. This way, they can be on a schedule to be opened and locked at the appropriate times. This technology also brings with it some good safety measures for all of us at Holy Family.

Rectory – The site work is underway for the new parish rectory. As you can see from the fencing, we did lose some parking for the construction phase. However, when it is completed, we will gain more parking overall.

Sidewalks – Some of the sidewalk work has been done, but there is a lot left to do. You will have noticed that 3 of the 4 church entrances have new sidewalks and the cement on the columns has been repaired. Currently, the portion of sidewalk in front of the church (on Chapel Drive) is under review. The hope is to eliminate the slope from the church to the road. This would be done by making the area right outside the church doors level and then put steps in. It would be ramped up to the area from both of the side parking lots to make it easily accessible. Again, this is all under review.

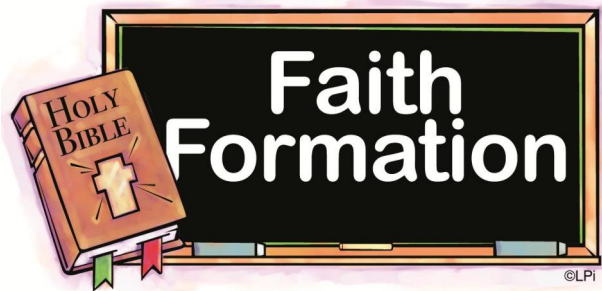

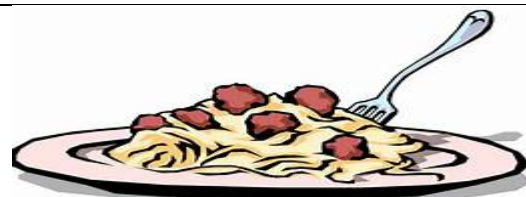
