PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Friends,

On Thursday, October 27, 2016 at 6:30 PM there will be a Listening Session in the church to discuss the daily Mass schedule and our reduction to one daily Mass in the near future. The Listening Session is an opportunity, for me, Fr. Jason, and our Pastoral Council to listen to your comments, concerns, and so on. At this time, no decision has been made as to what Mass we will cancel or if there will be a new Mass time and what time that will be. This is an opportunity for listening and then going forward making a decision with the advice of our Pastoral Council. My style of leadership is one of listening and collaborating. I am

not one to make decisions from the "top down" and impose them. I truly am open to the input of all. We are facing a reality in our parish and that is that we have less priests. Right now, Fr. Jason and I are covering our parish the best that we can. When one of us takes a day off, a vacation, the other priest is often left doing two daily Masses and a funeral (or two) and sometimes a wedding. There have been times when both of us have celebrated three, four, or five Masses a day. Thanks be to God that we have not been sick as it would create a burden on the other priest. Some have said, "Can the retired priests help out more?" That is a good question, and the answer is, yes they can. However, we cannot always assume they are going to be available to help as they are being called on to cover other parishes and some deal with different health issues that make it difficult to assist. I feel it is important to create a schedule and a pace here at Holy Family that will be healthy and beneficial to the priests that serve our parish. I ask for your patience and understanding as we move forward and let's always pray for each other, that together God will bless us as we journey towards His Son! I look forward to your presence and input on October 27 at 6:30 PM.
