Hope Appeal 2018

As of Tuesday, October 24, 2018, Holy Family Church has raised \$178,954.47 in the annual Hope Appeal. Our goal is \$117,482.77. As you can see we surpassed our goal, which is a great tribute to the faith and generosity of the parish family. Thank you so much for your generous giving. Currently, 27% of our parish has given to the Hope Appeal, which is 8 percentage points less than our desired goal of 35% giving. If you have not given yet, there is still time to do so. Please know your goodness to the appeal subsidizes the Mass for shut-ins, hospital chaplains, college campus ministry, vocation promotion, youth and young adult programs, evangelization programs, and so much more. Your generosity brings Jesus to so many. This is the best year for the Hope Appeal at Holy Family Church in the history of the appeal. Thank you for being a blessing to others!
