



Pastor's Notes

Dear Friends,

All of us have read over the past seventeen years, with great sadness, about the reality of clergy sexual abuse. Every single day, I pray for those who have been victimized by priests, religious, and lay people. I cannot imagine the hurt and betrayal they feel and my heart goes out to them. As I lift the victims up in prayer, I pray that these horrific acts never happen again in the Church, in families, and public institutions. As your pastor, it is my responsibility to make sure that we have a safe environment here at Holy Family – for our kids and for everyone.

It is a big responsibility to provide a safe environment for all at Holy Family and the reality is that I cannot do it alone. I feel so blessed to have very talented and capable people to support me in this role. I especially want to thank Lorraine Pigula, our Safe Environment Coordinator, at Holy Family. In addition to facilitating Safe Environment Training Sessions, she has been a tremendous resource in assisting us in creating a “culture of safety” at Holy Family. In other words, we don’t just go through a training session and think that we are done with it; we are constantly on the look-out for things that can be improved or done better for an overall safe environment for everyone. At the same time, I am grateful to our Parish Staff and our School Faculty and Staff for their diligence in assisting in this task of creating and maintaining safety for all. Furthermore, I want to thank Jacqueline Bressette, the Victims Assistance Coordinator for the Diocese of Syracuse and Julie Hagan, the Safe Environment Coordinator for the Diocese of Syracuse. I know they are only a phone call away and they are so good and helping us provide a happy and safe place here at our parish.

Today, if I may be so bold, I would like to ask for your help in this endeavor. I would like to see all of us truly commit ourselves to being good stewards of all that God has given us here at Holy Family and to ensure that safety is a priority. Currently, at Holy Family the only people that have to go through Safe Environment Training are those in direct contact with children. I am respectfully asking that every adult in ministry consider going through the training. While I am not making it a mandate, I truly believe it is beneficial for all. Moreover, if any adult would like to go through the training, I encourage you to sign up

for one of the sessions – here at Holy Family or elsewhere. To sign up just go to, <https://www.syracusediocese.org/safe-environment/initial-training-for-adults>. Whenever I ask people how the training has gone, they say, “I should have done this many years ago. It was a real eye opener.” It just doesn’t apply to Church circles; it applies to all aspects of life.

As a parish dedicated to the Holy Family, I pray that we will all work together to make sure that every member of our family feels safe and protected as they come to our campus in an effort to come to know, love, and serve the Lord.

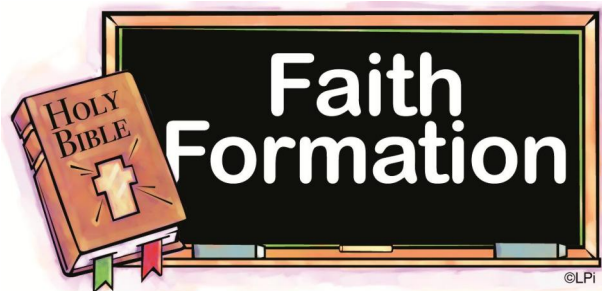
