

**PASTOR'S NOTES**

Dear Friends,

One of my obligations as pastor is to ensure that our property is well maintained, cared for, kept up, and preserved. All of this is done so we can enjoy our property (God's property) now and well into the future. I hope and pray that in 50 years and beyond people can come to this area and see that the Holy Family Church campus is the gateway not just to the far west side, but to eternal life!

Every year we do assessments of our buildings and grounds. As you can see and know - there is a lot to maintain. Over the past two years it has been increasingly evident that there are significant needs on our campus. For example, we know that our church flat roof, which is now 22 years old, needs to be replaced (roughly \$150,000). When you walk around our campus it becomes clear that our sidewalks need to be replaced. Not only are there stains on the concrete, most are chipped and cracked. They can only be patched so many times before they need to be replaced (\$200,000). The same is true of our parking lots – they have been patched many times over the past several years and all of them have large cracks, dips, bumps, and so on. Our maintenance crew is outstanding in their care of all aspects of our campus, but they can only do so much and you can only patch something so many times before you have to say it is time to resurface our lots (\$500,000). Also, we know there are significant needs in the parish rectory. The roof, plumbing, electrical (plumbing and electrical mostly original to 1947), all the bathrooms are in rough shape, the back of the house has a rotted sill, there are significant cracks in the foundation, moisture behind the plaster walls, and the list goes on. The reality is clear and has been discussed and approved by our parishioners at a town hall meeting and our parish leadership – it would be more beneficial to build new than to repair the current building. Lastly, the school roof, gym roof, and school boiler will need attention in the near future. As you can see, it is a big list of items and they are not cheap, but they are extremely necessary. In total, we are looking at 2 to 2.5 million dollars worth of much needed work. As you know from your own homes, these things are not cheap and we cannot do without them.

In an effort to help us prepare for the future, I have asked, at the recommendation of our Pastoral Council and Finance Council to employ the help of John Kearns and Associates to assist us with a capital campaign to raise the money needed so that we can adequately prepare for the future. You will hear more about the campaign going forward and I hope you will recognize that this is work that needs to be done so that future generations will be able to enjoy all that we do now and more! Holy Family is the largest parish in the Diocese of Syracuse and we will be here for many years to come. Our good stewardship now will ensure a healthy, vital,

strong Catholic parish and school today, tomorrow, and well into the future.

Thank you for all you do for Holy Family, your generosity and your sacrifices are a true sign to me of the great faith that you possess!

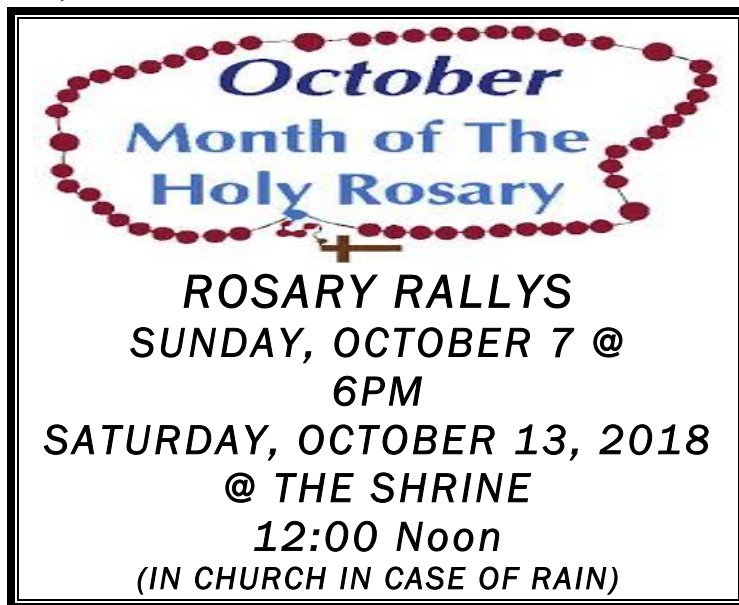
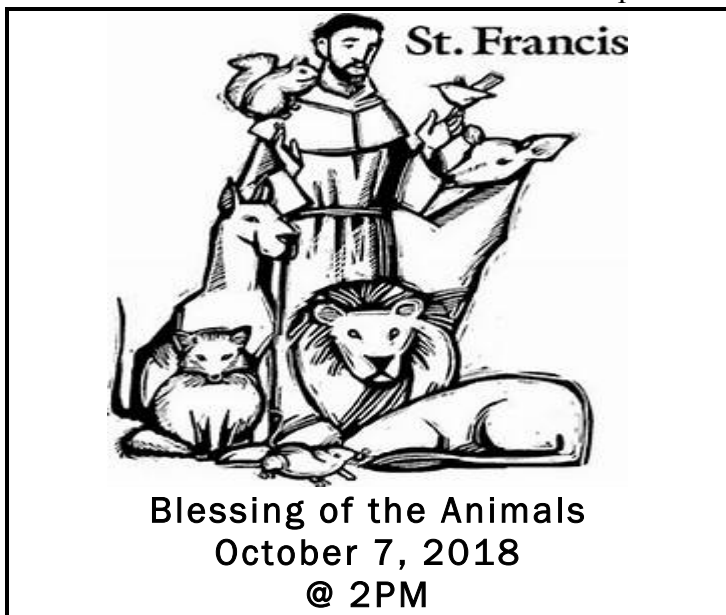
