REVIEW FOR LECTORS

- Encourage devotion to the Word of God
- How to comport oneself in the sacristy
 - Sacristy is a place of quiet and reflection...especially for the priest
 - New Lector's Corner!
- When carrying Book of the Gospels, do not stand book straight up...place it face down on the altar in between the corporals
 - Do not bow in procession when carrying the Book of the Gospels
- When approaching to read at the ambo, bow towards the altar and not the tabernacle
 - The tabernacle has already been reverenced during the entrance procession
- Please read slowly and clearly
 - Speak into microphone
 - Make good use of the Lector's Workbook to prepare well
 - Prepare both readings in case the other lector is absent
 - No need to welcome the community to Mass before you read the antiphon
 - What to do if readings are marked on the wrong page at Mass
 - If you are doing the second reading, please remove the Lectionary after the reading is concluded
- Check-in to see if you need to do Intercessions
 - Ask someone if you are not sure on how to pronounce a name
 - When praying the Intercessions *please stand in place* until the priest has concluded the prayer
 - Do not leave the ambo until the Intercessions are complete
- Be ready to assist young altar servers if they look confused
