2016 Hope Appeal...By the numbers

Every parish has a goal for the annual Hope Appeal. Our goal at Holy Family is \$117,841.97 (this goal is derived by taking a 3 year average of our ordinary income). To date we have raised 134.35% of our goal. Currently, in gifts and pledges we have raised, \$158,342.79. Our average gift per donor is \$196.19. To date, 807 families (since we have 3,500 families, this represents 23% of our parish) have made gifts to the Hope Appeal. Since half of the overage comes back to the parish, we will receive \$20,250.41 (plus more if people continue to give. You can still give to the Hope Appeal and remember that if you do, half of what you give comes back to the parish. **Thank you, thank you, thank you** for your generosity to this appeal and helping to share the love and presence of Christ with so many throughout our seven county Diocese. God will repay us a hundredfold for our generosity!

REGISTER EARLY! - CLASSES BEGIN SUNDAY 9/25 & MONDAY 9/26

The following changes will be made in the upcoming year to improve Faith Formation:

- **Grades K, 1, 3, 4, 5 & 6:** will be offered on Sundays from 10-11:15am and Mondays from 6:15-7:30pm.
- **Grade 2 Faith Formation:** will be offered **only** on Monday nights from 6:15-7:30pm. The sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are taught during Grade 2 and it is necessary that your child is thoroughly prepared. It is highly recommended that if you have a child in Grade 1 that they attend Faith Formation in order to help prepare them for the upcoming Grade 2 Sacramental Preparation year.
- **Grade 7 & 8 Faith Formation:** will be offered on Monday nights **only** in the Church Hall from 6:15-7:30pm. This will be taught using the EDGE ministry curriculum.
- **Confirmation 1** will continue on Sundays from 10-11:30am and **Confirmation 2** will continue on Sundays from 11:45am-1:15pm. There will be 3 required masses for C1 and C2 to attend as a group and this is during a class time, with C1 attending mass at 10:30 and C2 attending at the 12:15 mass. If you have a child who attends parochial high school, it is required that they attend the **second** year of Confirmation but, it is not mandatory that they attend Confirmation 1. (Though it is highly recommended that your child does attend).
