Dear Parishioners,

Recently, one of our parishioners asked me if I had been keeping up on all of the information regarding what has taken place with Archbishop Theodore McCarrick (formerly Cardinal McCarrick, the retired Cardinal Archbishop of Washington, DC). In case you have not heard, about a month ago it was revealed the Archbishop McCarrick, had sexually abused a child when he was a priest many years ago in the Archdiocese of New York. Since that revelation, other cases of abuse against the retired Archbishop have come forward including a case of sexual abuse of a child and sexual abuse of seminarians and priests. The investigation of McCarrick is still underway, but it is clear that many, if not all, of these cases are credible. Even more shocking was the news that while McCarrick was bishop of the Diocese of Metuchen, NJ and then the Archdiocese of Newark, NJ, financial settlements were paid out to two victims of his abuse – one in each diocese. These victims were not minors, but they were still victims of McCarrick's abuse – he abused his power as a bishop to prey on young men, especially, young seminarians and priests. Have I been keeping up on all of this? Most definitely. How do I feel about it? I feel it is safe to say that I have experienced the whole gamut of emotions – disappointment, anger, sadness, disgust, and so on. More than anything, I have gone to God in prayer for those victims of McCarrick and all who have fallen victim to clergy sexual abuse. I have been praying fervently that these issues will be addressed, that the silence will stop, that other victims will have the courage to come forward, and that

reparation will be made for these most grievous sins that have taken place at the hands of those few priests, deacons and bishops.

While I have gone to our Lord in prayer, I recognize that more can be done, by the Pope, Cardinals, Bishops, Priests, Deacons, and the Laity. This is something we need to work at collectively. I would like to recommend four (4) things regarding this for all of us to ponder. I feel this applies to all walks of life, not just the Church.

1. *If you see something, say something...* If you see something or sense there is an issue around someone that might be abusing a child/minor/vulnerable adult – say something – tell someone. To be silent does not do anyone any good. Say something.
2. *Go to the police...* If you know of a case of abuse of any kind – Go to the police. Let them handle it as they are the proper authority and our first recourse with these issues. They are professionals and are more than willing to help, listen, etc.
3. *If you have been abused or know someone who has – please speak out, share your story...* This may be the hardest thing that you ever have to do, but it can truly help you and others. Your voice, sharing your story, could prevent abuse in the future. Please pray for that courage.
4. *Be committed to stopping abuse...* This can be done through prayer, advocacy, supporting groups that help victims, and work to stop abuse, and so on. All should be committed to this – everyday.

Remember, when it comes to these issues in the Church, we are all in this together, in the sense that we need to work together to ensure that any abuse is documented and reported. Over 40,000 people in our diocese have gone through VIRTUS training, which is the program used to train all people how to work with minors and how to ensure a safe environment for all throughout our seven county diocese. We have taken steps and have been proactive. Currently, I am reviewing our policies and procedures here at Holy Family. Not only do I want to make sure they are being implemented and followed, but I want to see what more we can do as a parish family to make sure that abuse of any kind does not take place on this campus and beyond. I want you to know that I take this very seriously. The worst thing I have ever had to do in my priesthood is hear the accounts of several victims of clergy sexual abuse. I will do everything I can to make sure it doesn't happen again by a bishop/priest/deacon/religious/lay person. I hope you will join me in this endeavor. It may require some time and commitment on our part for training, studying, and praying. So, I hope I can count you in for this.

I love our Church, I love our Catholic faith. I abhor the actions of a few. The few do not and should not lead us away from God but to Him, seeking His help and wisdom for a solution. Please join me in prayer for all victims of abuse. I pray that our God and the intercession of our Blessed Mother will bring them some comfort and healing. Let's pray for each other, that here at Holy Family Church, we will commit ourselves to creating a safe environment for all.
