Hope Appeal 2018

Currently, 701 families or 23% of our parish has contributed to the annual Hope Appeal. Our goal as a parish is to get as many as 35% of our parishioners to participate in the annual appeal. Therefore, we are 12 percentage points off the goal. Recently, someone asked, “Why should I give to the Hope Appeal?” The answer is simple, it helps to bring Jesus to over 250,000 in the Diocese of Syracuse. The Hope Appeal supports, Catholic Charities, food pantries (including ours here at Holy Family), soup kitchens, homeless shelters, marriage counseling, marriage preparation, family life initiatives, pro-life initiatives, youth and young adult programs, catechetical programs, college chaplains, hospital and nursing home chaplains, Catholic Schools, the televised Mass for shut-ins, and so much more. Furthermore, a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family because when we exceed our goal, half of the overage comes back to us for our use. Over the past three years the Diocese has given us nearly \$75,000 in Hope Appeal overage. If you have made your gift or pledge, thank you for your generosity. If you have not made your gift or pledge, please do so as soon as possible. While it is important that we meet and exceed our goal, it is even more important that everyone get behind this great appeal as it does indeed bring Jesus to so many. Someday, when we stand before the Lord, He will thank us for our great goodness in helping to share Him with others and ultimately, leading others to heaven. Thank you so much for all you do!
