**More On Our Parish Capital Campaign**

From generation to generation parishioners of Holy Family have responded to the challenges of their time with generosity, humility and passion. Today we are the beneficiaries of a magnificent inheritance from previous parishioners who originally built this parish and grew this church. It is through their sacrifice and generosity that we are able to worship, learn and socialize in a parish setting rich in beauty and history. This legacy, and our facilities, serve as a source of pride for all Holy Family parishioners to share. After numerous meetings during the past two years with the Pastoral Council, Finance Council, staff and a listening session, we have determined that we must make major improvements, repairs and updates to our parish campus. In response to these needs, we will be launching a parish capital campaign entitled *Our Faith - Our Family - Our Future*. This campaign will address the need to build a new rectory as well as replace roofs on both the church and school. In addition funds raised from this campaign will be used to address numerous repairs and updates throughout our property which will ensure the long-term viability of Holy Family Church. We are currently in the organizational phase of our campaign and plan to continue with additional phases starting in January 2019.
