PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Friends,

Happy Advent! Know of my prayers for a blessed Advent that gives way to the beauty of Christmas. So often, this beautiful season gets lost in the midst of all we have to do. Let's pray that this year we can capture the beauty of the holy season, which will prepare us to celebrate the Lord's birth with joy!

In the near future we will be publishing our parish financial report. I can tell you now that both the church and school had a good year last year thanks to your ongoing generosity and goodness. There are some things to consider as we go forward when it comes to finances. First, prior to my arrival, plans for remodeling our parish offices were in the works as part of the capital campaign that was done a few years ago. As you know, the parish offices are the old convent and they are in need of updating and upgrading. We hope to begin that project after the first of the year. We have been working with a contractor and architect to determine our needs and we think we are in a good place. So, we all look forward to this project. Another project in need of serious consideration is our parish rectory. The rectory was built in 1947 and has served us well, but we know that all of our plumbing and electrical (wiring) needs to be replaced, a new roof is needed, new siding, new windows, our heating/air conditioning needs to be upgraded, just to name a few items. As is typical in most parishes, the rectory is often overlooked because of other needs within the parish. But, as you can see, we have some big items to replace that need to be considered. One of the things that we have to look into is whether or not we spend a significant amount of money in repairs and remodeling or do we look into new construction. This is a discussion for our finance council and our pastoral council to consider. Some other needs we will be looking into are the sidewalks and church roof (the flat roofs are now 20 years old, which is about the life expectancy for a flat roof). So, as you can see there will always be something to be addressed on a campus this size.

Thank you for all you do for Holy Family. Due to your generosity and the sacrifices you make our parish is strong and vibrant. Thank you for all the blessings you offer to Holy Family as it truly brings the presence of Christ to so many.
