Dear parents with young children,

You may have noticed the new sign in the Multi-Purpose Room, which reads as follows:

“This room is especially dedicated to all parents with young children. We would like to give a warm welcome to all parents who bring their children to Mass. Consider this room your space.”

This sign was put there by Father Manno and Father Hage. The reason this sign was put there was to clear out the Multi-Purpose Room so that it could be used for what it was originally intended...as a “cry room” during Masses. Over the past year that room has been effectively cleared out for the use of our children, but now parents with young children are not utilizing the room. We would encourage all parents with young children to utilize this space as your own, especially when a child has become excessively noisy during the celebration of the Mass. If you are wondering what “excessively noisy” means, here is a helpful principle to use: if your child has been crying or yelling for more than two minutes, then it may be time to walk them back to the Multi-Purpose Room. Of course, we are overjoyed by the presence of our young children. The presence of young children means that our parish is alive and full of promise. Take the above recommendation with a grain of salt. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
