While you may not see a lot of activity on the outside of the new parish rectory, much is taking place inside. The basement concrete slab has been poured and the framing of the lower level is complete. The plumbing and electric installation is well underway as

is the HVAC system. Next week the insulation will go in and then the drywall. So, overall it is progressing nicely. The hope is that the rectory will be complete by May 1, 2020 and then work can be done on the parking lot. All of this is happening at a good time as there have been significant plumbing issues in the currently rectory that are being held at bay until the new rectory is complete. Thank you for your on-going support, patience, and goodness through this time of construction.

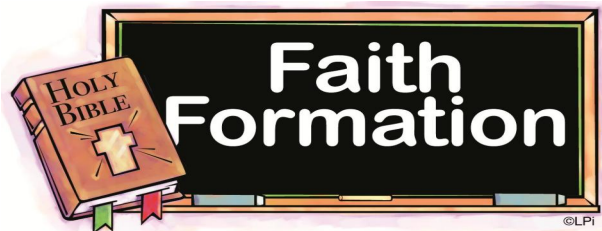
